Candidates with experience in Library data processes, CRM design, and notice/contact scheduling scenarios will be preferred.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Full-stack development with a focus on UI/UX React or Java (Spring Boot)
- FOLIO module development or modification, based on specific requirements of public libraries
- Active participation in the online FOLIO community
- Understanding and implementing library data processes, their workflows, and related reports
- Participating in CRM design and notice/contact scheduling scenarios

Work Hours

This is a remote position within the US. Preference will be given to residents of Washington State, particularly Spokane. Some conference trips or in-person events may be required.
