Spokane Public Library to reopen Central Library on July 11

After two years of being closed for renovation, Spokane Public Library is hosting a grand reopening celebration for Central Library (906 W. Main) on July 11 from 9am to 3pm. Tour the renovated library, grab lunch from local food trucks on-site, and attend a variety of events throughout the day.

A ribbon cutting ceremony will start at 9am by the northside entrance on Spokane Falls Blvd. Hear from Mayor Woodward, City Council President Breean Beggs, Senator Andy Billig, Washington State Librarian Sara Jones, and more. A Vietnamese Lion Dance performance by the Vietnamese Youth Association will follow the ribbon cutting and lead guests into the library.
